

Lovebug Lollipop Valentine

This cute little critter was so easy to make, and the kiddos had so much fun making their own little lollipop valentine. I decided to stick with the typical red ladybug but a pink one would be so cute too! This little guy or I guess little lady would be a perfect gift for your kids to make for their friends or teachers. Hope you have a crafty and Happy Valentine's Day love bugs! Supplies:

- Lollipop
- Construction Paper (Black, pink, and red)
- Glittery Heart Foam Cutouts
- Googly Eyes
- Pipe Cleaners/ Fuzzy Sticks (Red or Pink)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Tape

Instructions:

1. Cut out your main shapes for your "lovebug" (A Large Black Circle Body, Large Red or Pink Heart Wings, & Small Black Circle Head. I used a plate and a cup to outline the circles and used the half heart paper trick to create the wings. Measure the wings against the circle to be sure they line up.
2. Align the "wings" against the body, fold the tip of the heart over the circle, glue wings onto the body.
3. Carefully cut two small slits in the very center of the lovebugs body to hold the lollipop.
4. Glue the smaller black circle underneath the body of the lovebug.
5. Glue the glittery foam heart cutouts on the wings as the lovebug's spots.
6. Glue the googly eyes on the head.
7. Cut one red pipe cleaner in half, and wrap around your finger to create the curled shape of the antennae.
8. With two pieces of tape, tape each antenna on the back of the lovebugs head.
9. Carefully stick the lollipop in the slits on the center of the lovebug, and your little bug is all done!
