

Sweethearts Candy Card

This sweetheart card is easy and fun for kids to make. There's plenty of sweet messages to write on each little "heart candy" or you can write one message with a letter in each heart, like I did! Those iconic red bold words always made me smile growing up, and now they bring back so many cherished memories. I had so much fun thinking about Valentine's Day as a kid while I made this one. Exchanging those little V-day cards in class were and still are some of my favorite elementary school memories.

Supplies:

- Paper*

*Be sure to use pastel colored sheets such as pink, green, purple, yellow, blue, orange and white for the "sweethearts"

- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Red Pen

Instructions:

1. Cut heart shapes out of the variety from a pastel paper stack.
2. Fold a piece of paper in half to create your card
3. Arrange and glue the paper "sweethearts" on the front cover of your card.
4. Finally, with a red pen, write your own sweet Valentine's Day message on the heart shapes.
