

Valentine's Rag Wreath

This wreath was so simple, under \$10 to make, and it turned out really pretty! I'm so excited to hang this up every year for Valentine's Day! As I put this fun wreath together, I played some sweet romantic music to get me inspired! Once I got the hang of it, this wreath turned out to be the most relaxing craft!

Supplies:

- Felt Fabric Sheets (3 of each color; Red, Pink, Light Pink)
- Metal Floral Wreath Base
- Tulle Fabric (Red or Pink)
- Glittery Foam Heart Cutouts
- Scissors
- Tacky Glue

Instructions:

1. Cut each felt fabric sheet in half, then cut those pieces in half again (hamburger style). This time cut the pieces in half, lengthways (hot dog style) and again. In total, sixteen 5" strips from each of the full fabric sheets.
2. Cut the tulle fabric in half and then into strips about 7" long, put them aside for later use.
3. Decide on a pattern you'll be arranging your felt fabric pieces to make the process easier. It doesn't have to be perfect, but I'd recommend not placing two strips of the same color next to each other. It can even be completely random.
4. Tying the wreath is easy but it takes a little patience and time. All you need is a simple knot for each strip. The wreath base that I have has 6 sections, each section has 4 bars to it. I tied about 6 fabric strips to each bar, feel free to tie more strips or less if you'd like your wreath fuller or less full, whatever you like best!
5. Once you've filled your wreath with the fabric, you can tie in the tulle strips wherever you'd like to. I used 2 or 3 pieces in each section of the wreath.
6. Finally, glue the glittery foam heart cutouts on the wreath with tacky glue. Press down immediately to ensure that the hearts are secure. Wait for the glue to completely dry, then hang your wreath and enjoy!
