

## “You Make My Heart Melt” Card Instructions

This sweet ice cream card was the most creative out of the 4 Valentine’s Day Cards created. It took a little bit more “skill” than the others, and it turned out to be my favorite of the four! I think it’s those silly puns that I love so much! Feel free to stick with the traditional pink and red “Valentine” colors, however don’t be afraid to get creative and make your cards unique! Come up with some other goofy puns of your own. Other favorite puns: “Have you heard the scoop?”, “I LOVE YOU!” and “You’re my cherry on top!”.

### Supplies:

- Paper (various colors/ designs, about 4 sheets)

\*Example includes: red, pink, cream, and pink polka dot scrapbooking paper

- Foam Heart Cutout (optional)
- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Black Fine Tip Marker
- Pencil

### Instructions:

1. Draw each part of the ice cream cone with a pencil. Lightly draw 3 “ice cream scoops” and three small “ice cream drips” on your colored paper of choice. Next, draw a triangular shape with a rounded tip to create the “cone” shape.
2. Cut out the 3 “ice cream scoops”, the three small “drips of ice cream”, and the “cone”.
3. Fold the sheet of paper in half for the main card.
4. First, glue the paper “cone” onto your card. After, glue a “scoop” right on top of the “cone”. Next, add the other scoops on top of one another, leaving a tiny strip of each layer showing. Glue the tear drop “ice cream melts” underneath the “ice cream scoops”.
5. Glue your foam heart cut-out on the very top “scoop” as the cherry on top! Draw a “cherry stem” with your marker.
6. Write a sweet message or pun on the front cover of your card.
